- Food Pick-Up** (week prior to ride) – Assist with picking up food donations
- Food Prep** (Friday) – Contact Jonny Hunter at the Underground Food Collective, jonny.d.hunter@gmail.com.
- Route Markers** (Friday only) – Assist with marking event route and posting signs along the way
- Site Set Up** (Friday only) – Set up tables, tents, chairs, and water stations at farm stops
- Orange Caution Sign Placement & Pick-Up Crew** (Early Saturday morning and late afternoon) – Place caution signs/yard signs along event route. NOTE: Need truck, minivan, or large wagon to transport signs.
- Bike Rack Transporters** (Saturday morning) – Transport 10' long bike racks from Near East Side to Token Creek Park and back. NOTE: Need vehicle with hitch and trailer.
- Greeter/Traffic Control** – Meet and greet riders as they arrive at farm sites; assist with directing traffic flow
- Informers** – Assist with rider check-in; relay information on event logistics at farm stops
- Registration/Merchandise Table** (Token Creek only) – Check riders in; hand out route maps; take rider pledges; hand out merchandise to riders at the after party
- Server** – Assist with serving food, snacks, and beverages at farm stops and/or after party at Token Creek
- Recycling Guru/Site Maintenance** – Collect recycling, compost, and garbage at farm stops; make sure water jugs are filled
- Sag Wagon/Bike Support** – Ensure rider safety on the road; provide basic mechanical assistance and support to bikers. NOTE: This is an all-day commitment.
- Medical Professional** – Contact Gini Knight, gini@macsac.org, if you are interested in providing medical support at farm stops.
